#### 1. Main report

#### Site Description

The site comprises the area of St Andrews Square Gardens, with the boundary wall and railings forming part of the Category A group listing with the Melville Monument. Date of listing;- 13 January 1966, LB reference;- 27816.

It is within the New Town Conservation Area and the Edinburgh World Heritage Site.

### **Site History**

07 November 2014 - Planning permission granted to erect ice rink, spiegeltent, bar, market stalls, nativity scene, box office, fairground rides and associated site office, stores and ancillary facilities (14/03914/FUL).

25 November 2013 - Planning permission granted for a spiegeltent, bar, market stalls, nativity scene, box office, fairground rides and associated site office, stores and ancillary facilities (Reference: 13/04041/FUL).

#### 2. Background

The enquiry refers to with the non compliance with condition 2 relating to application 14/03914/FUL with specific concerns relating to the gardens, kerbs and footways not being returned to their condition prior to the occupation of the event.

As this is a breach of planning control, this matter has been passed to Essential Edinburgh to arrange for the appropriate reinstatement works to be undertaken.

It is recommended that no further enforcement action is required at this time.
